#### Enlighten us - but make it quick!

At this year's GPEDC Forum in Korea, up to 8 participants are invited to give a 5 minute lightning talk. Do you have something you want to share about your work on the Busan agenda? This is your opportunity.

#### The topic:

Describe how you overcame a challenge your daily work, relating to one of the four Busan principles:

- 1. Ownership of development priorities
- 2. Focus on results
- 3. Inclusive development partnerships, and
- 4. Transparency and accountability.

#### **Guidelines for the lightning talk:**

- Please just pick one challenge and one Busan principle. Don't aim to cover too much in your talk
  less is more.
- The aim of a lightning talk is to inspire and inform your audience, but you only have 5 minutes, so you must get to the point! And be as creative as you like – lightning talks can be fun and informal.
- Aim to share one important lesson learned at the end of the talk that others will find useful.
- Unfortunately, we don't have translation facilities, so please prepare to speak in English.
- Speakers will get a buzzer after 5 minutes please keep to time or you will be cut off.

Talks will start promptly at **12.30pm** on the 24<sup>th</sup> November, after lunch, in the main hall. (Attendance is voluntary, but if you choose to sit in the main hall, please be respectful of speakers.)
