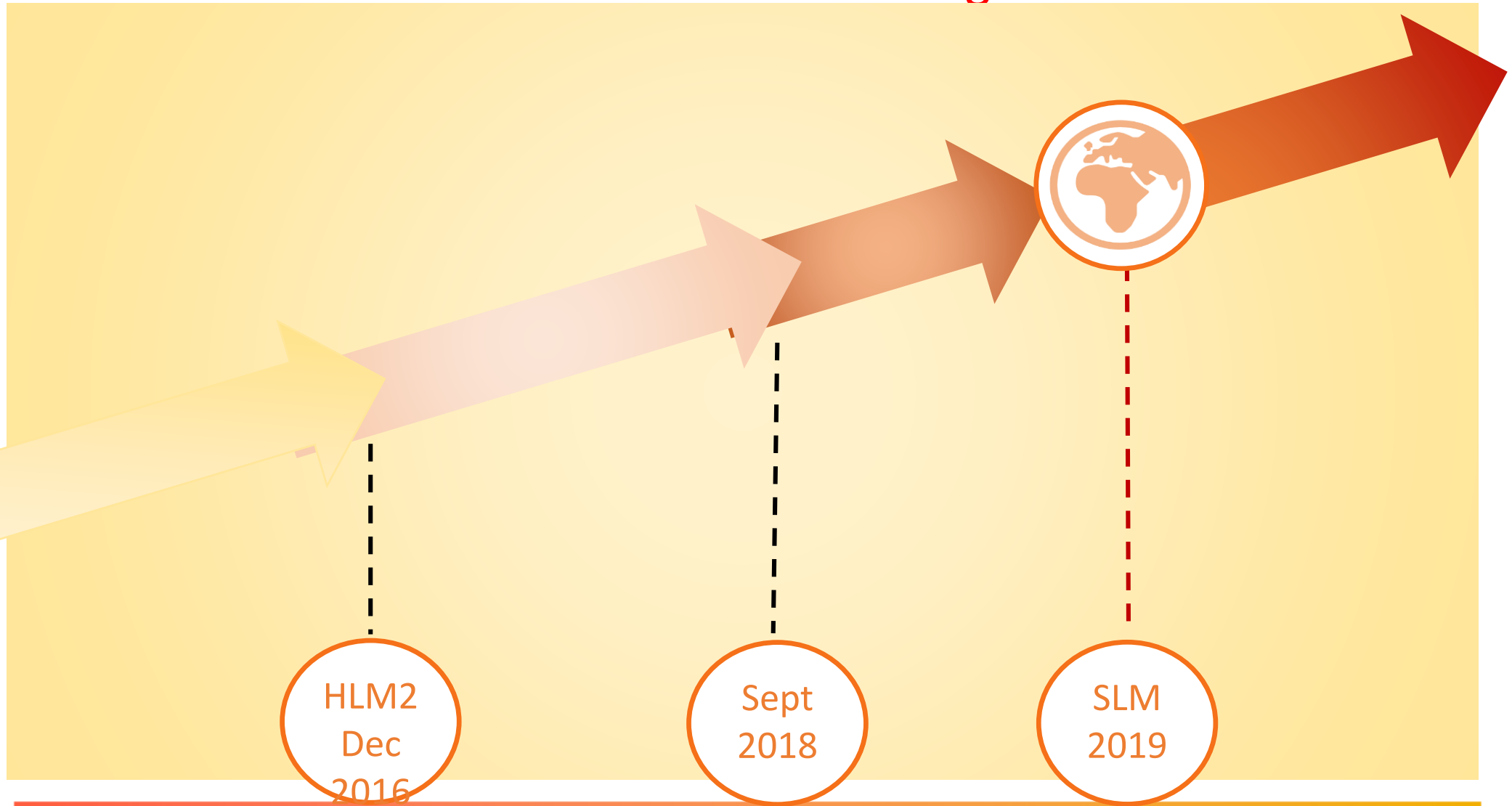

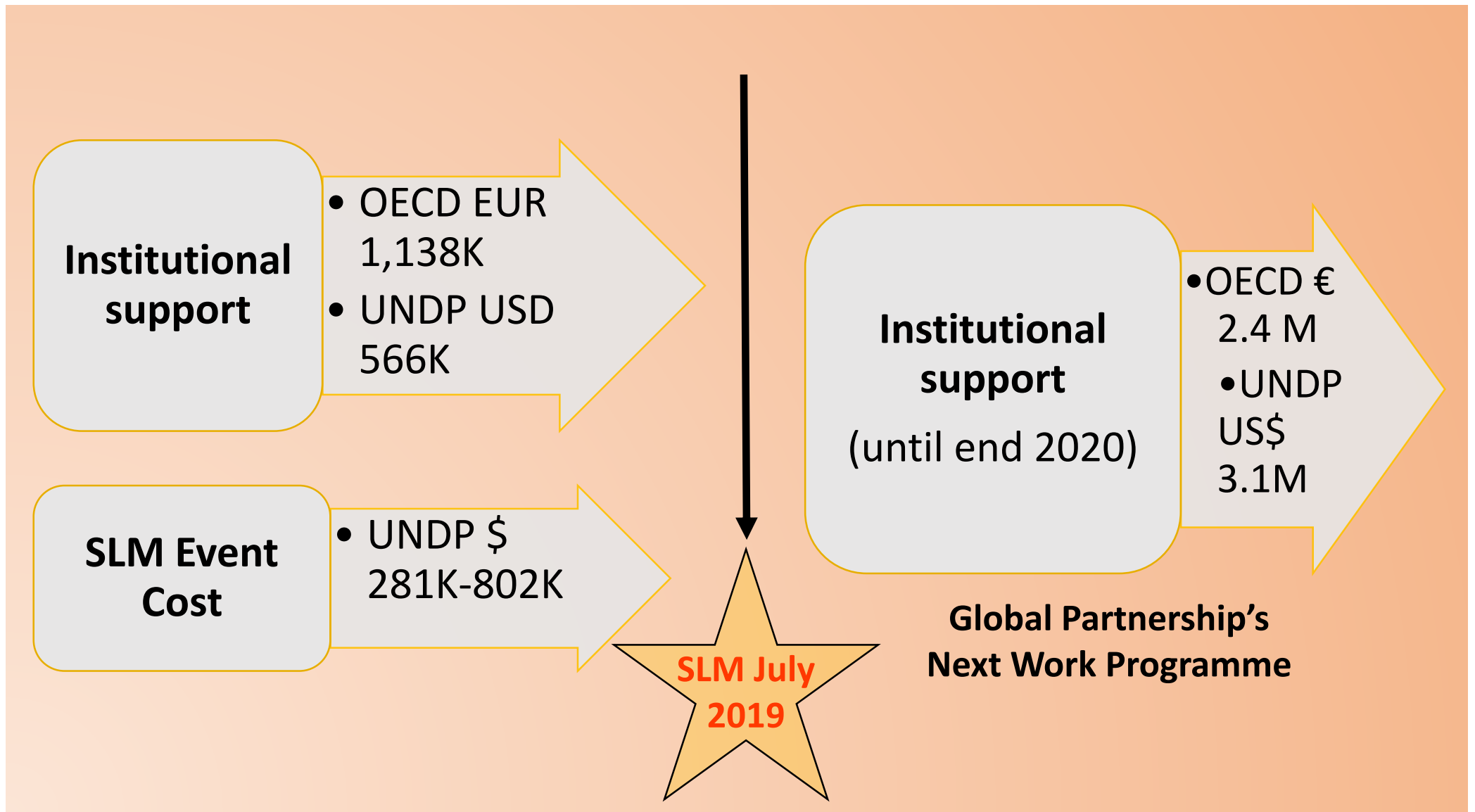

Reporting: Expenditure reports, progress
narrative for UNDP global projects

Building on comparative strengths of both organisations

OECD-Detailed funding packages in
conversation with interested partners.

UNDP-Detailed Budget and supplementary
information available.
Submission of a specific funding proposal in line
with a required procedure of funding providers
