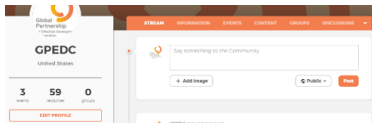
## 1 What is the GPEDC Knowledge Platform?

Create your very own profile on the Platform and follow other like minded members much like Facebook and Twitter!



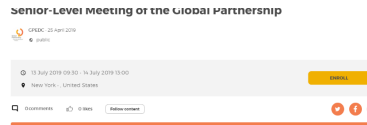
### Resources

Stay informed and follow events happening around the world. You can also create and share your own event!



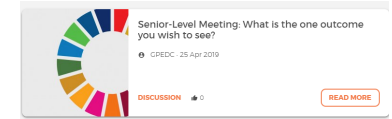
### Groups

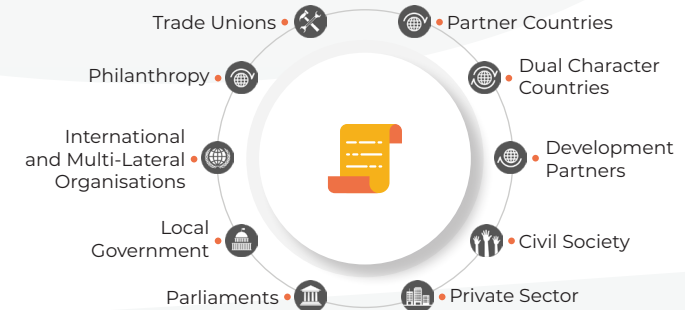
### Discussions
